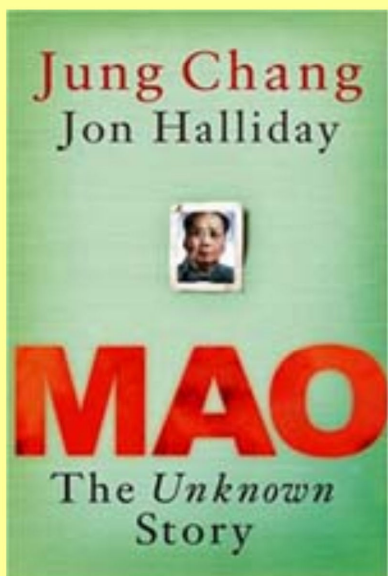

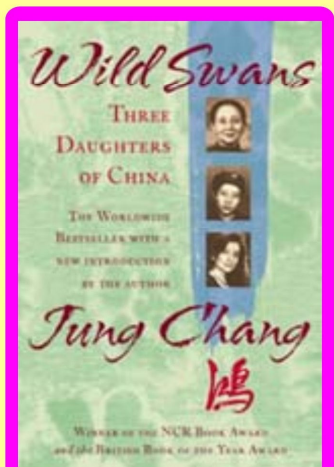


ABOUT SPEAKERS



JUNG CHANG:

Jung Chang is the author of the best-selling book ***Wild Swans - Three Daughters of China***, which has sold over 12 million copies and been translated into 32 languages. *Wild Swans* has won many awards, including the NCR Book Award UK (1992), UK Writers' Guild Best Non-Fiction (1992) and Book Of The Year UK (1993). Her biography of Mao Tse-tung, ***Mao: The Unknown Story***, was published in English in 2005 and in Chinese in 2006. The book has been published in 30 languages. Dr Chang has been awarded honorary doctorates from the Universities of Buckingham, York and Warwick, the Open University and Bowdoin College, USA. Jung Chang was born in Yibin, Sichuan Province, China, in 1952. During the Cultural Revolution (1966-1976) she worked as a peasant, a 'barefoot' doctor, a steelworker, and an electrician before becoming an English- language student and, later, an assistant lecturer at Sichuan University. She left China for Britain in 1978 and was subsequently awarded a scholarship by the University of York, where she obtained a PhD in Linguistics in 1982 - the first person from the People's Republic of China to receive a doctorate from a British University.

JON HALLIDAY:

Jon Halliday is a historian of Russia and former Senior Visiting Research Fellow in the Department of War Studies at King's College, London University, researching the secret Russian role in the Korean War. Born in Dublin, Ireland; he got a degree in Literae Humaniores/Greats (Ancient Greek, Latin, Ancient History and Philosophy) at Oxford University in 1961. He has taught at universities in Italy and Mexico. He was the author of a 6-hour television series on the Korean War (for British, US [PBS] and Australian TV), broadcast in the late 1980s in some 20 countries.

In 2005 ***Mao: The Unknown Story***, which he co-authored with his wife, Jung Chang, was published in the UK and USA, and has since sold more than 1 million copies and been published in 30 countries. He is the author/editor of eight other books on Japan, the Korean War, Albania, the cinema and the Psychology of Gambling.
