PROF. DR. PETER KUNZMANN



He is an active academician, deeply involved in the study of the Human-Animal Ethical Relationship with respect to their co-existence in Nature. As an expert to enlighten on this issue, he is sought after across Eastern and Western European countries as well as North America.

He holds the office of Professor at the Institute of Applied Ethics at Friedrich Schiller University, one of the most prominent universities of Germany. He has several works to his credit and one of his co-authored books called *Atlas Philosophie*, has been published by the renowned German publisher, dtv, which is translated into 20 major languages of the world.

Born and brought up in the Franconian province of the State of Bavaria, he obtained his Doctorate in Philosophy and later the Habilitation from the University of Wuerzburg; he also has an advanced degree in Catholic Theology. As the Alexander von-Humboldt scholar he worked at the Zielona Góra University, Poland. He is a member of the *Commission on Science and Values* at the Saxonian Academy of Sciences and of the *European Academy of Sciences and Arts*.
