Prof. Saurabh Dube to deliver lecture on 'Modernisms in India' at ICG

The International Centre Goa (ICG), BITS Pilani (Goa Campus) & Department of History, Goa University are co-organising a lecture on 'Modernisms in India' by Prof. Saurabh Dube; Professor of History, CEAA, El Colegio de México. This lecture cum interactive session is part of ICG Lecture Series by Eminent Persons and will be held at The International Centre Goa, Dona Paula at 11.00 am on Tuesday, 12th January 2016.

Saurabh Dube is Professor of History in the Center for Asian and African Studies, El Colegio de México. Ph.D. in History, University of Cambridge and M.Phil. in History, University of Delhi. During the lecture Prof Dube will explore the terms of modernism(s) on the Indian subcontinent. He will focus first on critical modernist moments, cutting across aesthetic forms and the twentieth century, in South Asia.

The lecture will be chaired by Prof Kumkum Roy, Professor at Centre for Historical Studies, School of Social Sciences, Jawaharlal Nehru University, and Visiting Research Professor under DD Kosambi Chair in Interdisciplinary Studies, Goa University. Entry to the programme is free and open to all interested in attending.
